Sarah goes to work every day. She is always there from 8.30 until 4.30.
 It is 11 o'clock now. Sarah **is** at work.
 At 11 o'clock yesterday, she **was** at work.
 At 11 o'clock tomorrow, she **will be** at work.

We use will for the future (tomorrow, next week):

Ex: Sue travels a lot. She is in Madrid today, tomorrow **she'll** be in Paris.
 I **won't** be here tomorrow.
 Will you be home this evening?

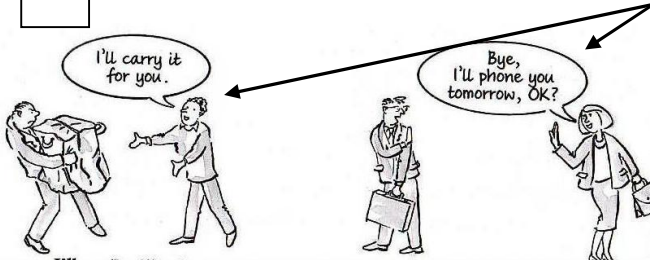

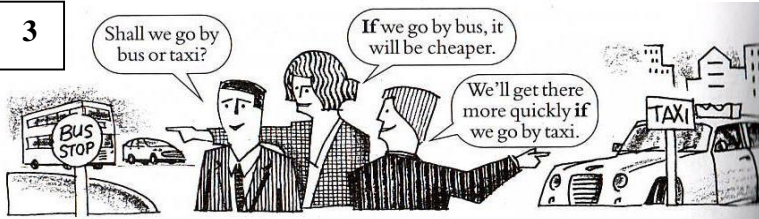


You can use will when you offer to do something.
